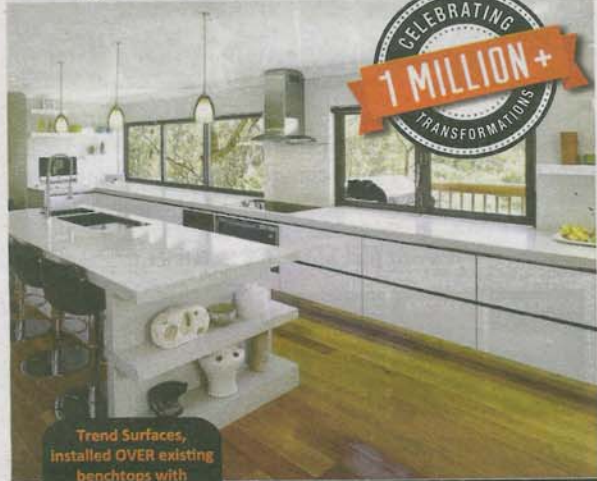

ARTWORK IMPRESSES

NUMBER OF ENTRIES UP

TANISHA Burtnyk has won the overall prize at the City of Joondalup's 2016 Community Art Exhibition.

Now in its 19th year, the exhibition was launched on Saturday night at its new home in the Myer Centre Court at Lakeside Joondalup Shopping City.

It features 192 works from artists that are either residents of the City or members of a non-profit visual arts association within the City. This is up from 126 entries last year.

"With a total prize pool over \$8250 and one artist selected for a \$3000 commission to produce an artwork for the City's Inside-Out Billboard project, it's little wonder this year's exhibition has generated so much interest," Mayor Troy Pickard said.

Nine awards were announced on Saturday night with the Popular Choice Award, given to the artwork that receives the most votes from the public, to be revealed later this month.

Burtnyk won for the most outstanding work in any media category for her piece *Untitled*. "Tanisha's delicate but dynamic work on paper is infused with subtle visual poetry and power, read both as an object and a drawing," the judges said.

The exhibition will be displayed across two levels in the foyer outside Myer Joondalup until June 25.
